



## Ministry of Commerce joins force with CIBJO in hosting CIBJO CONGRESS 2017 to underline Thailand's position as world's gems and jewelry hub

Delegations of the World Jewellery Confederation (CIBJO) has paid a courtesy visit to Mrs Apiradi Tantraporn, Commerce Minister of Thailand, to present a letter of acceptance on the occasion of hosting the CIBJO annual congress in Bangkok, Thailand later this year.

The Commerce Minister has welcomed the President of the World Jewellery Confederation, Dr Gaetano Cavalieri, and CIBJO Coral Commission Mr Vicenzo Liverino. The CIBJO Congress 2017 will be scheduled on November 2-7, 2017 at Shangri-la Hotel, Bangkok. The CIBJO Congress 2017 coincides the 60<sup>th</sup> edition of the Bangkok Gems and Jewelry Fair, to be held on September 6-10, 2017 at Challenger Hall 1-3, IMPACT Muang Thong Thani.

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
