THAILAND'S COMMERCE MINISTRY HOSTS 72ND BANGKOK GEMS & JEWELRY FAIR

Thailand's Ministry of Commerce is hosting the 72nd edition of the Bangkok Gems & Jewelry Fair from 9–13 September 2025, at the Queen Sirikit National Convention Center (QSNCC). The fair, one of the world's top four trade shows in the industry, is expected to generate over USD 100 million in trade value.

Organized by the Department of International Trade Promotion (DITP) with support from the Gem and Jewelry Institute of Thailand (Public Organization) or GIT along with public and private partner organizations, the event will feature 1,106 companies across 2,628 booths. More than

40,000 international visitors are expected.

DITP Director-General Sunanta Kangvalkulkij emphasized the fair's global significance, noting its continuous run for over 40 years. "The Bangkok Gems and Jewelry Fair is a key platform for international trade, connecting entrepreneurs and buyers worldwide," she said. "It has grown to become one of the most important exhibitions globally, and the largest colored gemstone marketplace in the world."

GITDirector-General Sumed Prasongpongchai highlighted strong exhibitor interest,

with demand exceeding available space despite the fair's recent expansion. He noted that renowned international jewelry brands continue to participate, reflecting confidence in Thailand's gem and jewelry sector.

The 72nd fair will also host a series of industry activities, including seminars, networking events, and a Thai jewelry exhibition. A key highlight will be the Thailand Gold Forum, organized in collaboration with the World Gold Council and the Gold Traders Association of Thailand, providing a platform for international knowledge exchange.

Thailand's gem and jewelry industry remains a major export driver. In 2024, exports excluding unwrought gold reached USD 9.6 billion, up 11.5% from the previous year. In the first half of 2025 alone, exports surged 63% to USD 7.4 billion, with top markets including India, Hong Kong, and the United States.

The fair is expected to further strengthen Thailand's position as a global hub for gems and jewelry trade. More information is available at www.bkkgems.com or via Facebook at Bangkokgemsofficial.








