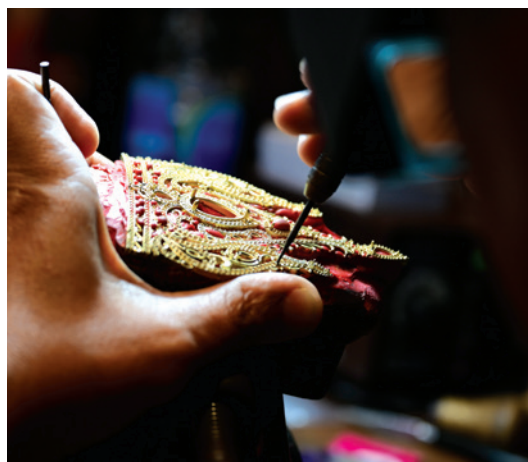

The Craft of Brilliance: Tracing Thailand's Jewelry Heritage

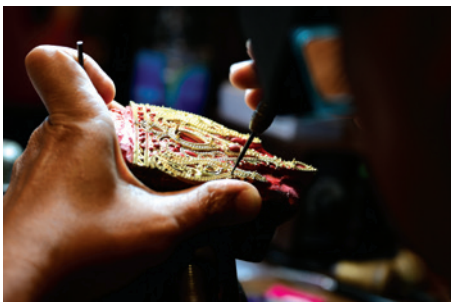

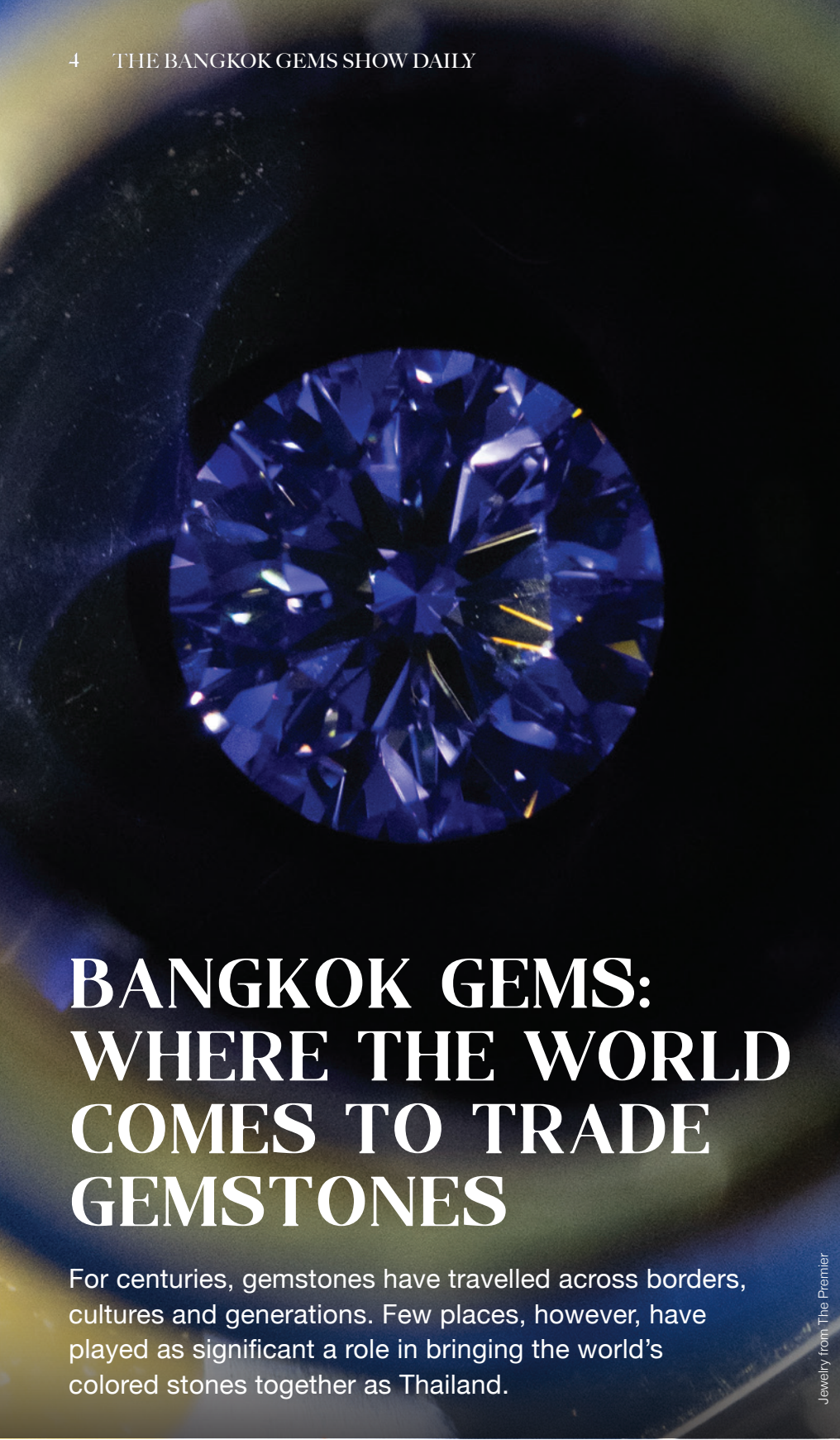
At the heart of the exhibition is the story of transformation: how natural gemstones and precious materials are refined through knowledge, precision and creativity to create pieces of

BANGKOK GEMS: WHERE THE WORLD COMES TO TRADE GEMSTONES

For centuries, gemstones have travelled across borders, cultures and generations. Few places, however, have played as significant a role in bringing the world's colored stones together as Thailand.

Today, Bangkok sits at the heart of the international gemstone trade, supported by generations of knowledge in sourcing, cutting, polishing, enhancement, jewelry making and global commerce. The city is more than a marketplace for precious stones; it is a place where nature's treasures are refined through expertise, precision and creativity.

This unique ecosystem comes to life at the **Bangkok Gems & Jewelry Fair**, where buyers, traders, manufacturers, designers and gemstone specialists from around the world come together to source materials, discover new opportunities and build lasting business relationships. From rough and polished colored gemstones to diamonds and pearls, the fair reflects the

extraordinary diversity of the global market while showcasing Thailand's particular strength in colored gemstones and value-added craftsmanship.

SUPPORTING THAILAND'S GLOBAL JEWELRY INDUSTRY

Behind Thailand's continued position as a global gems and jewelry hub is strong institutional support, with the **Department of International Trade Promotion (DITP), Ministry of Commerce**, playing a key role in connecting Thai businesses with international markets. Through trade promotion, export development, international business matching, overseas market expansion and initiatives that strengthen the competitiveness of Thai entrepreneurs, DITP helps bring Thailand's gems and jewelry expertise to buyers around the world. Its support for the **Bangkok Gems & Jewelry Fair** further strengthens the event as an international platform where Thai manufacturers, designers, traders and emerging brands can meet global buyers, develop new partnerships and expand their presence in the world market. Together with industry institutions and private-sector partners, DITP helps create the conditions for Thailand's craftsmanship and creativity to translate into sustainable international business opportunities.

A LEGACY BUILT ON COLORED GEMSTONES

Thailand's reputation as a gemstone center has been built over generations. Its expertise in cutting and polishing, combined with specialized gemstone enhancement and jewelry manufacturing, has established the country as a trusted destination for international buyers. What distinguishes Thailand is the depth of knowledge across the value chain — from sourcing and selecting stones to cutting, enhancement, grading, setting and transforming them into finished jewelry.

At Bangkok Gems, this expertise can be seen in both the people behind the trade and the exceptional gemstones themselves. One example is **Gemburi**, a Thai gemstone company that reflects the country's deep expertise in sourcing and working with colored gemstones. With a

focus on carefully selected natural stones, Gemburi showcases how Thai businesses combine access to exceptional gemstones with specialist knowledge, precision and an understanding of what international buyers and designers are looking for. Its presence at Bangkok Gems illustrates the diversity of Thailand's gemstone sector from established trading expertise to contemporary businesses that continue to build value around the country's strengths in colored gemstones.

Another example from Thai company **The Premier** is a 46.25-carat Natural Ceylon Blue Sapphire in Royal Blue, examined and certified by the Gem and Jewelry Institute of Thailand (GIT). Alongside it is The Premier's proprietary Sunflower Cut Diamond, a distinctive round cut featuring 65 facets — 33 on the crown and 32 on the pavilion — arranged in a sunflower-inspired pattern to enhance the way the diamond interacts with light and create an especially lively display of brilliance. Together, these exceptional stones demonstrate how Bangkok's gemstone industry brings natural rarity, gemological expertise, precision cutting and innovation together to create lasting value.

A MARKETPLACE BUILT ON TRUST

For international gemstone buyers, Bangkok's appeal extends beyond the sheer variety of stones available. The city offers an established professional ecosystem where technical knowledge,

craftsmanship, certification, manufacturing and international trade operate side by side.

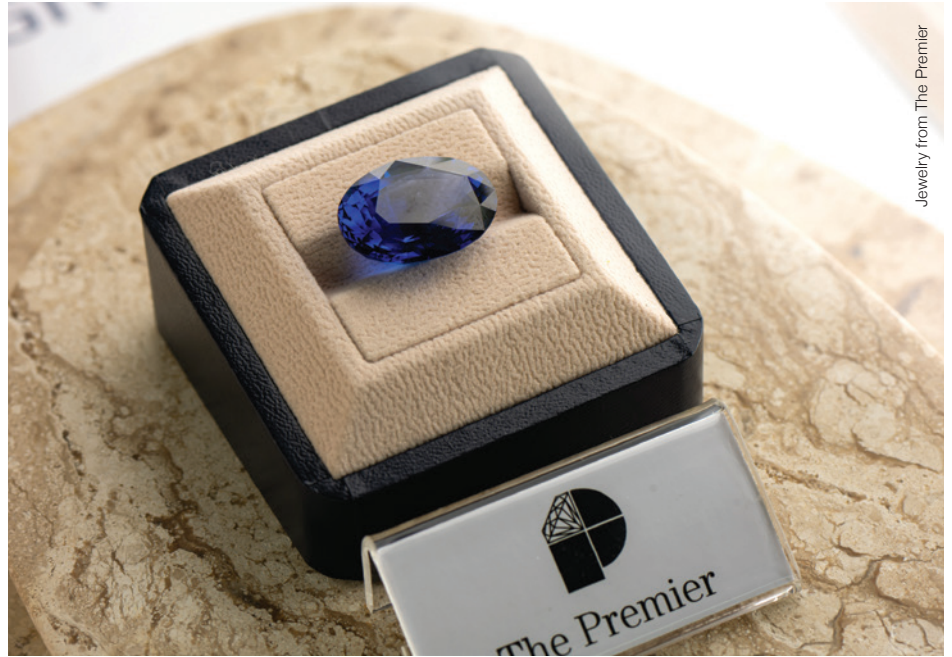
Institutions such as **GIT** play an important role in this ecosystem. Gemological testing and certification provide buyers with reliable information to support informed purchasing decisions, while Thailand's network of skilled cutters, manufacturers, traders and designers enables gemstones to move seamlessly from sourcing to finished jewelry.

At Bangkok Gems, this combination of natural rarity, human expertise and

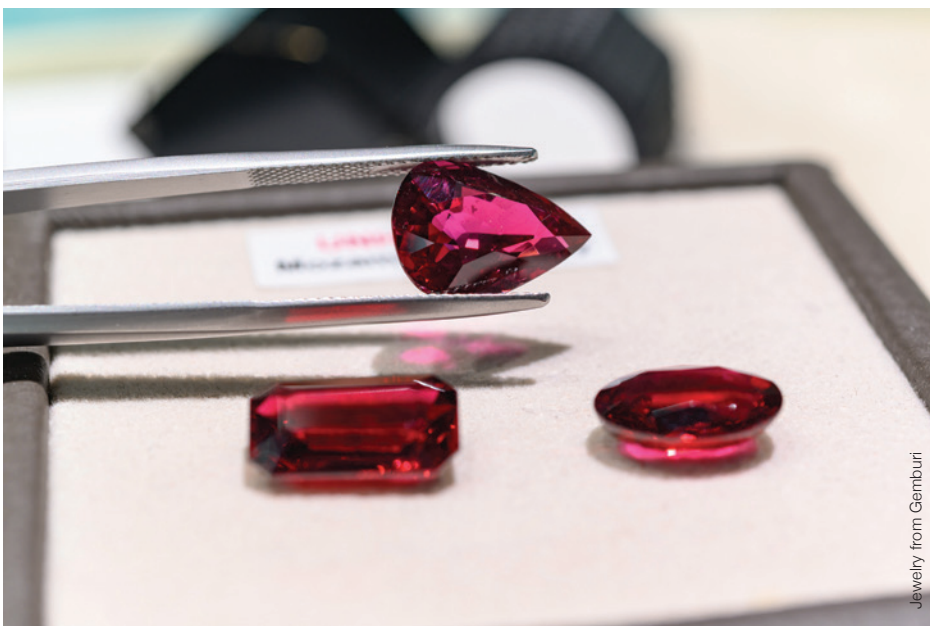
professional standards creates an environment built on confidence. Buyers can compare stones, meet trusted suppliers, explore new cutting and design possibilities, and develop relationships that can grow well beyond the exhibition floor.

WHERE THE GLOBAL GEMSTONE TRADE MEETS

The significance of Bangkok Gems lies in its ability to bring the gemstone world together under one roof. A buyer searching for a rare colored gemstone can connect with a trader with decades of experience. A designer can discover an unusual stone that sparks a new collection. A manufacturer can meet a supplier and develop a new product. And an international business can access the technical knowledge, craftsmanship and production capabilities needed to transform an idea into a finished jewel. This convergence makes Bangkok more than a destination for gemstone trading. It is a meeting point between nature and craftsmanship, tradition and innovation, and local expertise and global demand. Ultimately, Bangkok Gems tells a larger story about the gemstone trade: a stone's value lies not only in its rarity, but also in the knowledge, precision and creativity that reveal its potential. Here, gemstones change hands, ideas take shape and partnerships are forged — ensuring that Thailand's role in the global gemstone trade continues to evolve and shine.

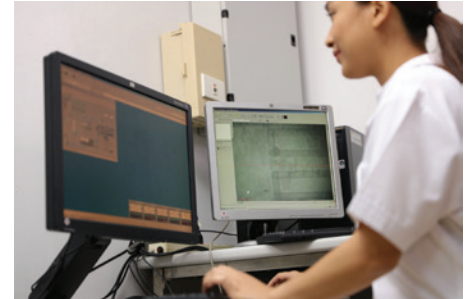

Becoming a Gemmologist: A Career Reskilling Gateway into the Global Gem Industry



Thailand's gem and jewelry sector is a major economic driver, ranking as the country's 3rd largest export industry in 2025 at USD 26.59 billion (~THB 800 billion). Yet, the industry's true foundation is market trust. Ensuring transparency requires certified experts like Gemmologists to test, identify, and verify gemstone authenticity.

Once considered an exclusive field for family businesses, gemmology today welcomes professionals from all backgrounds seeking to reskill. To support this demand, The Gem and Jewelry Institute of Thailand (GIT), supervised by the Ministry of Commerce, partners with Gem-A (UK), the world's oldest gemmological association, to deliver the Gemmologist Diploma Program in Bangkok.

HANDS-ON MASTERY AND INTERNATIONAL QUALIFICATION

Priced at THB 380,000, the 450-hour curriculum balances theory with intensive lab training. Students master identifying and evaluating natural, synthetic, and treated gems while building trade confidence and preparing for the international English-language examination.

Graduates earn the globally recognized Fellow of the Gemmological Association (FGA) diploma, granting official authority



to sign Gem Identification Reports and unlocking career opportunities across global trade networks.

STRATEGIC LOCATION & COLLABORATIVE LEARNING

Situated on Silom Road in Bangkok's prime gem district, GIT connects classroom training directly with market dynamics. Students explore real-world trading hubs while learning alongside local and international peers under mentorship from GIT's veteran gemmologists.

RESKILL FOR A HIGH-TRUST CAREER

Whether upgrading existing skills or switching fields, earning an FGA diploma provides a future-proof career path that upholds transparency and confidence in the global gem trade.

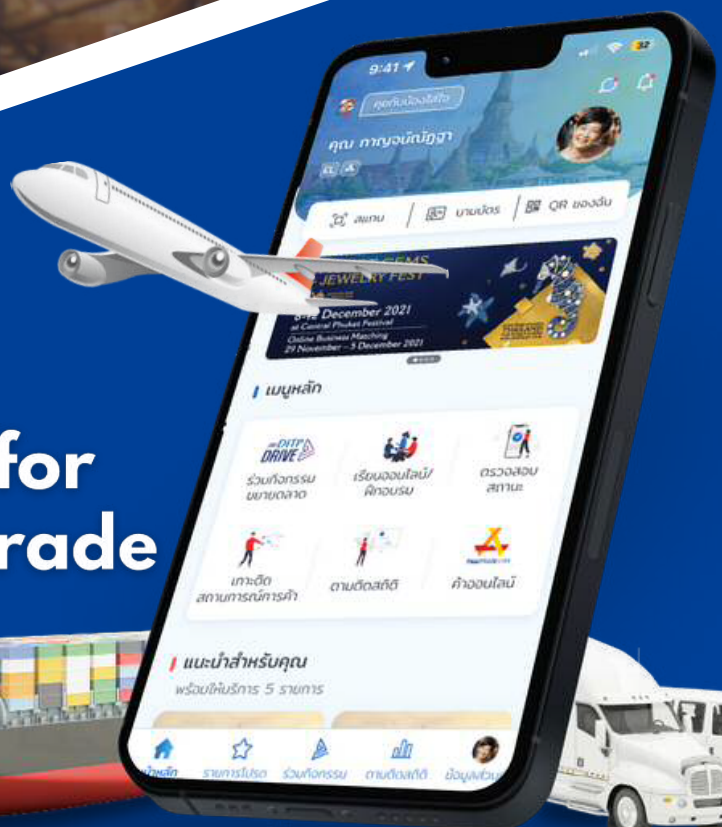

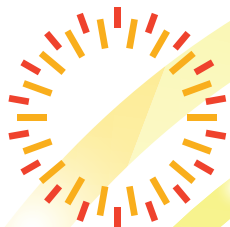
